Many claimants receive salary/pensions/lump sums/continued employment after being injured. Details of these benefits should ideally be provided on form F.

For an injured child provide evidence of earnings of father (for boy) and mother (for girl) on form E, or alternatively a report from an industrial psychologist. Where possible pre-injury school reports should be provided.

For an injured woman there may be a loss of homemaking capacity, ie ability to perform domestic chores. Evidence should be provided as to cost of replacement services.

ADDITIONAL DOCUMENTATION REQUIRED (where applicable)

- 1. WORKMEN'S COMPENSATION CERTIFICATE
- 2. MEDICAL REPORT (stating claimant's mortality, if not normal. This is also required if claimant was in poor health **prior** to the injury.)
- 3. REPORT BY PROSTHETIST (costs of artificial limb).
- 4. REPORT BY OCCUPATIONAL THERAPIST (appliances and need for attendant).
- 5. REPORTS BY MEDICAL PRACTITIONERS (future operations, medication, consultations, etc).
